HANGTIME wines demonstrate the superior quality of Pinot Noir & Chardonnay from appellations where grapes spend long periods of “hangtime” ripening on the vine. A long hangtime in the vineyards contributes to concentrated flavor. Winemaking that focuses on the flavors of the grapes allows us to deliver delicious wines that express the appellation of origin.

APPELLATION - AOC* Burgundy is a historic region of east central France. The region’s core is the fertile Rhone and Saone river valleys, where routes from Paris and the Rhineland to the Mediterranean converge. One varietal that thrives in the volatile and constantly changing vineyards of Burgundy is Pinot Noir. Winemakers with a love for the Burgundy region know how to work with the diversity and promise the land offers to bring wine lovers a wine they can count on.

2005 GROWING SEASON By all accounts Mother Nature was smiling on Burgundy throughout the 2005 growing season. Generally speaking, the growers were able to harvest grapes at their leisure, due to the warm, dry conditions throughout the region. Burgundy wines from the 2005 vintage will show rich, intense flavors of red and black fruits, flowers and minerals; true terroir expressions.

WINE DETAILS The grapes for the 2005 HANGTIME Pinot Noir from Burgundy, were on the vine for a minimum of 107 days. Burgundy, the historic origin of Pinot Noir, was a natural source of fruit for Hangtime Cellars. Growers in burgundy have been cultivating Pinot Noir grapes with complex character, vibrant flavors, and rich texture for over 2000 years. The 2005 HANGTIME Pinot Noir was crafted to be enjoyed upon release or allowed to develop beautifully over time.

*AOC (**Appellation d’Origine Controllee**) is defined as the designation for wines of better quality from France, in our case Burgundy. It is a set of laws which help the consumer to determine the origin and quality of a wine. These laws dictate the grape variety, the minimum alcohol and other quality factors, for any given wine from a specific region.
